



## **ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2023**

To: Scholarship Applicants

Thanks for your interest in pursuing a Nebraska Association Scholarship. Please review the qualifications and if you meet the requirements submit an application.

Please provide the required information and return your materials to your teams head coach for selection by your own team's scholarship committee. Once the application package is reviewed, and if you are selected as the final candidate for the scholarship the packet must be submitted by your teams head coach or designee by the established deadline (which will be posted on the Nebraska Association USATF website). The application will then be approved by the scholarship committee of the Nebraska Association of USATF. If any details or requirements of the scholarship application are in question the Nebraska USATF Scholarship Committee will make final judgements and rulings on those questions from year to year prior to awarding the scholarship.

Good luck in your pursuit of scholarship opportunities. We hope to be able to assist you in your pursuit of higher education. Hopefully you will be part of our team of scholarship recipients this year. The announcement of recipients will be made in January.

Actual monetary awards will be distributed by the Nebraska Association once acceptance and full time registration into your selected educational institution is verified by Nebraska Association of USATF via the submission of official registration and class scheduling documents.

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### Who is eligible?

- Graduating high school seniors** from Nebraska public, private, and independent schools. Home schooled youth will be considered on a case by case basis with proper verification of grades.
- First semester senior high school year **cumulative and unweighted GPA of at least 2.0** on a 4.0 scale
- At least **three consecutive personal years of active membership with USA Track and Field (XC or LDR)** Must have at least **three consecutive and active years** (active is verified by **participation** in at least 1 non JO event each year of claimed activity) Activity must be with with the same certified active Nebraska Association track team (Multiple team participation is a disqualifying factor).
- Unattached athletes may be considered by teams as their single recommended award recipient (making the “Multiple Team” participation restriction void in these cases only and these athletes need only be active 3 years with USATF Nebraska).
- Active NE USATF teams must consist of at least two members and must have at least four years of full membership with NE USATF
- Must be a member of the team that is submitting the initial application
- Must be registered and able to display class scheduling at a **four year certified institution in the United States** (two year institutions will be considered on a case by case basis each year).
- Candidates **displaying the intent to continue participation in the sport of track and field or cross country** will be given preference in final selections.
- Must display strong character and sportsmanship. (**no displayed record of discipline with USATF or school in a two year period**)
- Final application submission must be received by the posted deadline December 1**

### Information about the award?

- One scholarship per certified and active team **ONLY** is available when awards are presented
- Awards are \$500 single year non-renewable scholarships
- The award will be announced at the Annual Youth Recognition Event and will be mailed direct to the recipient upon confirmation of registration in classes and acceptance in a qualified institution
- Nebraska USATF reserves the right to reduce the annual amount of some or all of the scholarship awards or discontinue the scholarship program from year to year dependent upon annual budgets

### How do I apply?

- Complete an application obtained from Nebraska USATF or its website
- Forward the completed **application** to your team head coach who will select one candidate to submit to Nebraska USATF/ **With Certified School Transcript & Proof of USATF & Team Membership- Please include a letter from a school counselor verifying no school disciplinary actions for the past 2 years**
- Nebraska USATF must receive your application from your team before the given deadline

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### **What college may I attend?**

- Winners may attend a four year institution that awards baccalaureate degrees within the United States
- Two year accredited colleges will be considered upon a case by case basis during the final selection process (by Nebraska USATF)

### **Is there any special considerations?**

- Consideration is given to youth athletes that can display plans to continue running in college**

### **What is considered an Eligible Club/Team?**

- A club/team must consist of more than 2 athletes.
- The head coach submitting scholarship applications to NE USATF must be listed on the USATF coach's registry for the final year of the youth's participation in NE USATF (the last season before graduation).
- A club must have a paid current year's plus three consecutive years membership at time of scholarship application.
- The club must be in good standing with their association without any outstanding issues including disqualifications from the previous year.
- A club must be a member of USATF for at least 4 years.
- A club must use the scholarship for one member per year
- Unused scholarships are not held over until the next year

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### **STUDENT: INFORMATION THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO BE PREPARED**

- Complete the entire application accurately far before the deadline (October suggested)
- Submit the application to a school representative for verifications (October suggested)
- Write a brief statement in the essay section
- Include a current and official signed transcript displaying current grades and cumulative GPA
- Forward to your club/team head coach for signatures, verifications, and judging before November 20
- You are responsible for all information being included and complete. Please copy your application, and check with your coaches frequently to assure timelines are met.

### **CLUB/TEAM COACHES: INFORMATION THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO BE PREPARED**

- Please know that student applications will be found on the website and can possibly be forwarded to you digitally if requested
- Pay close attention to deadlines so that important information can be turned in on time to avoid application disqualifications (December 1)
- Please be aware of your team status for the last four years and communicate with applicants to avoid disappointment as applications will be disqualified if your team has not been in good standing
- By September/October timelines anticipate request and questions about scholarship applications
- Expect situations where multiple students submit applications. Please be fair in the selection process
- It is suggested that you form a two or three coach application review team to judge your candidates if your team has more than one graduating senior
- Only one application will be accepted by Nebraska Association of USATF from an individual team. The student and team must assure the application is complete. NE USATF will simply reject incomplete applications. No feedback will be provided. No corrections are allowed once final review is done at the NE USATF level.
- Multiple dimensions have been addressed in the application forms to allow for fair and independent evaluation of your team candidates (academics, participation, character, etc.) Candidates will be judged in a unbiased fashion on the merits of their individual applications and personal achievements.
- Nebraska Association will only become involved in the final review and offer assistance in unresolved scholarship issues.
